



BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION MINOR REQUIREMENTS

Overview of the Minor Program

The Lundquist College of Business offers a minor in business administration, which is intended for students majoring in other disciplines who want a solid introduction to business management.

- A minimum grade of C- (C- or P in lower division courses) is required in all minor courses.
- Twelve upper division hours must be taken in the Lundquist College of Business.

In order to declare the minor, students must **not** have a Pre-business, Business, or Accounting major declared.

Minor Courses

BA 101 Introduction to Business

BA 215 Accounting: The Language of Business Decisions (or ACTG 211)

BA 315 Economy, Industry, and Competitive Analysis (or Econ 201 & 202)

BA 316 Management: Creating Value through People

BA 317 Marketing: Creating Value for Customers

BA 318 Finance: Creating Value through Capital (or FIN 316 if you are an economics major and have maintained a 3.0 GPA)

Students must take BA 101 before taking any other minor courses
and BA 215 is required before taking BA 318.
