To calculate your GPA

1) Find your quality points

Quality points= credit hours for each class multiplied by point value of the grade earned in that class

2) Find your GPA

Divide total quality points (calculated from step 1) by total credit hours earned

*Note to Community College Transfers: If you transferred from a school that had a 3- course accounting series (211, 212, 213), you should figure all 3 courses into your Pre-Business Core GPA. You must have both ACTG 211 & 213 from a Community College to receive credit for ACTG 211 at the UofO.

*Pre- Business Core classes taken Pass/No Pass will be counted as a C- when calculating the Pre-Business Core GPA. However, they will have no affect on the cumulative GPA.

*Students may retake a Pre-Business Core course one time. For the purpose of figuring your Pre-Business Core GPA, use the second grade received. For the purpose of your cumulative GPA, both grades will average together and both remain on the transcript. However, you will only receive credit for one.
