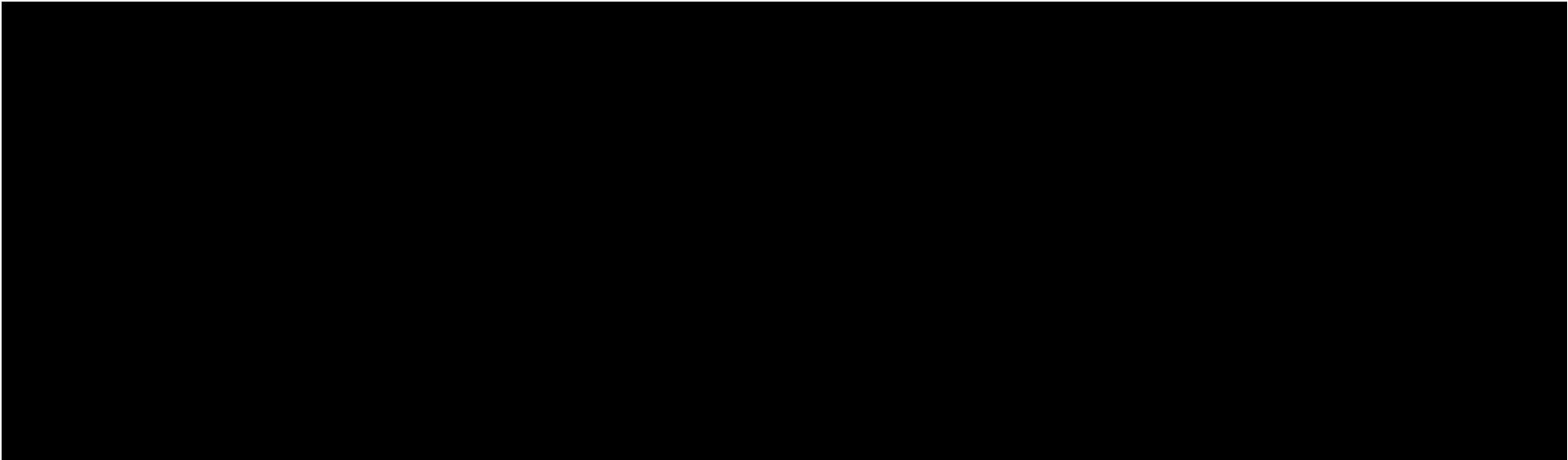

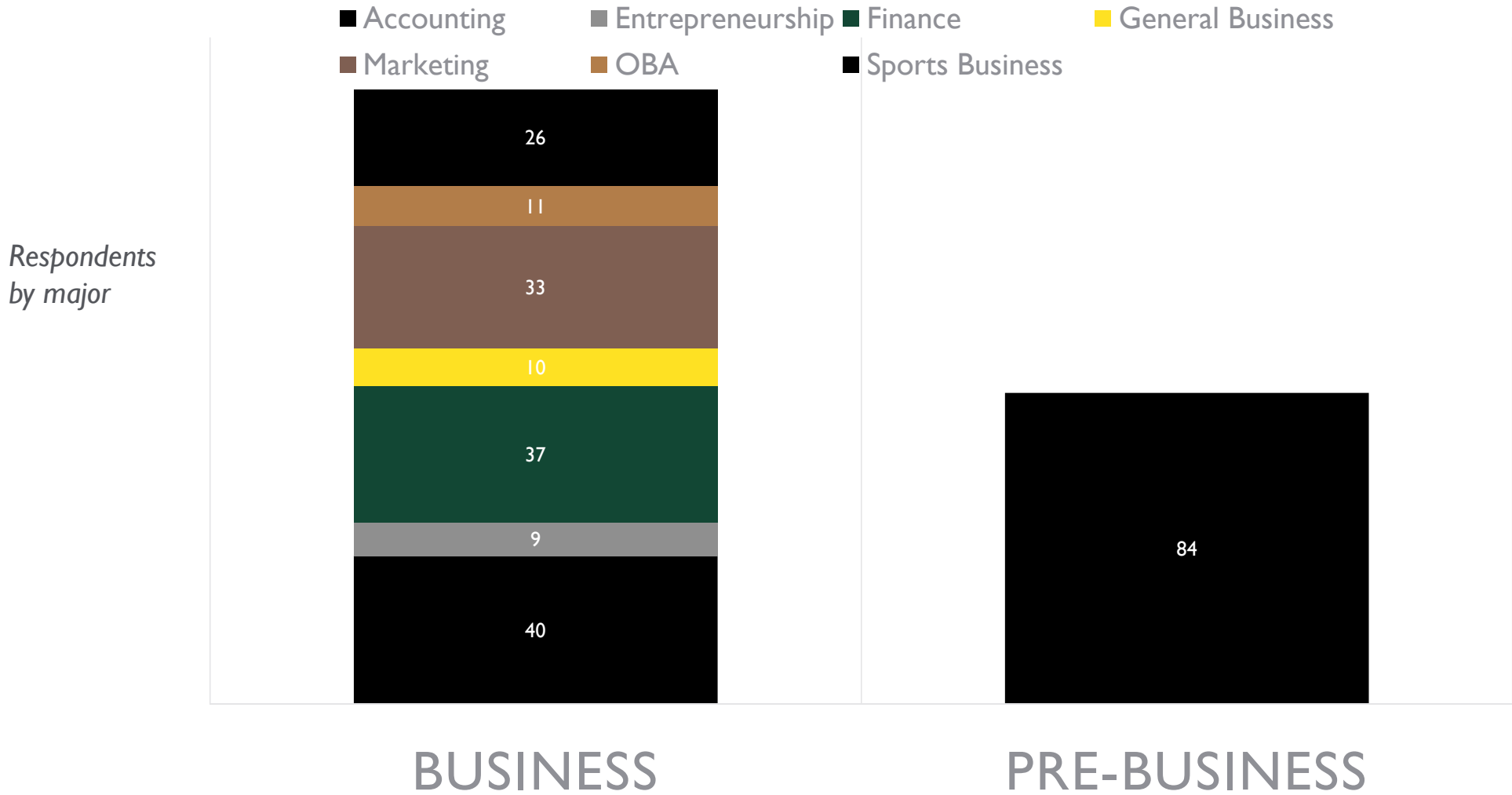

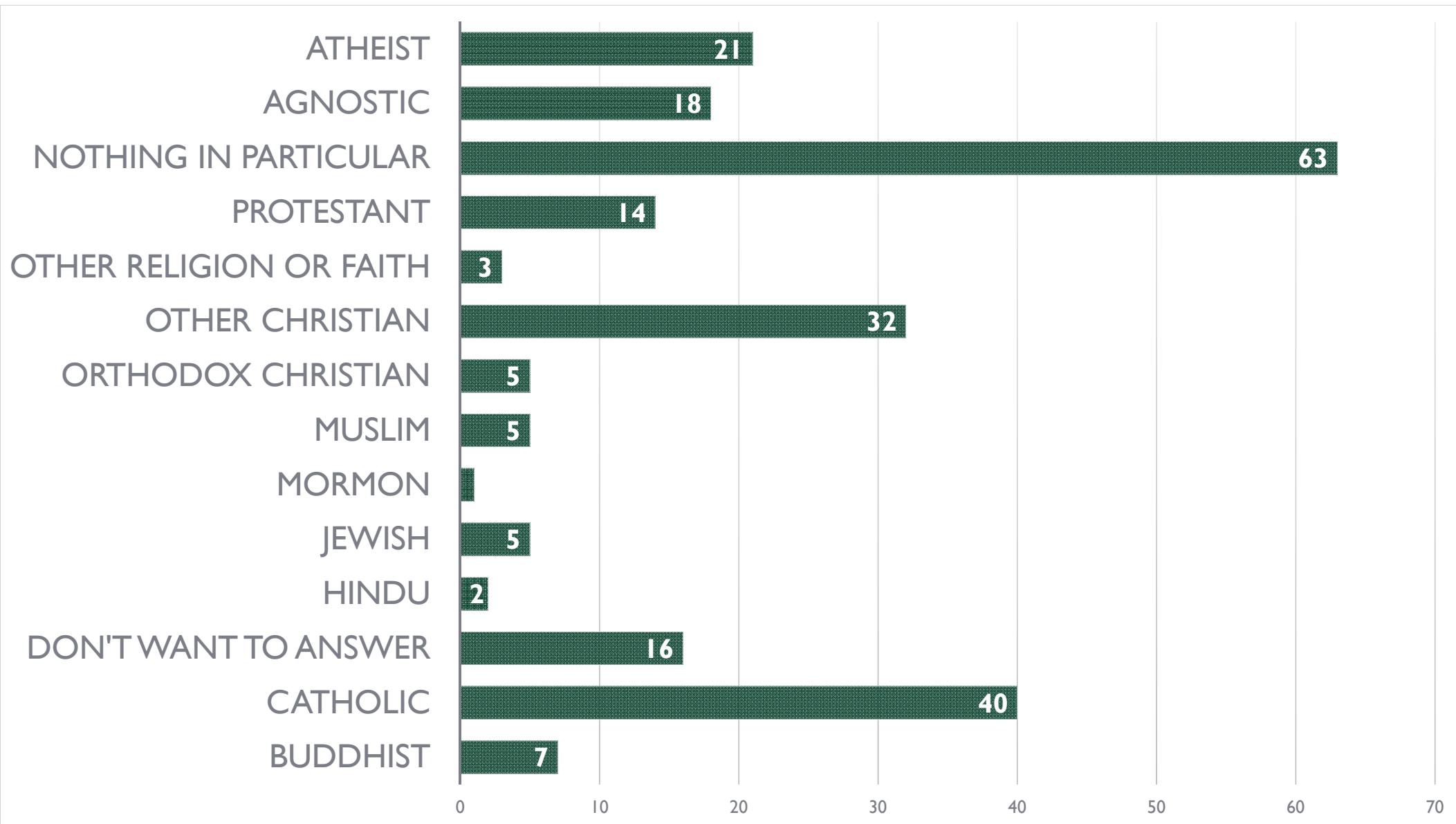
327 participated, 245 completed (82 partial responses)

Some stats...

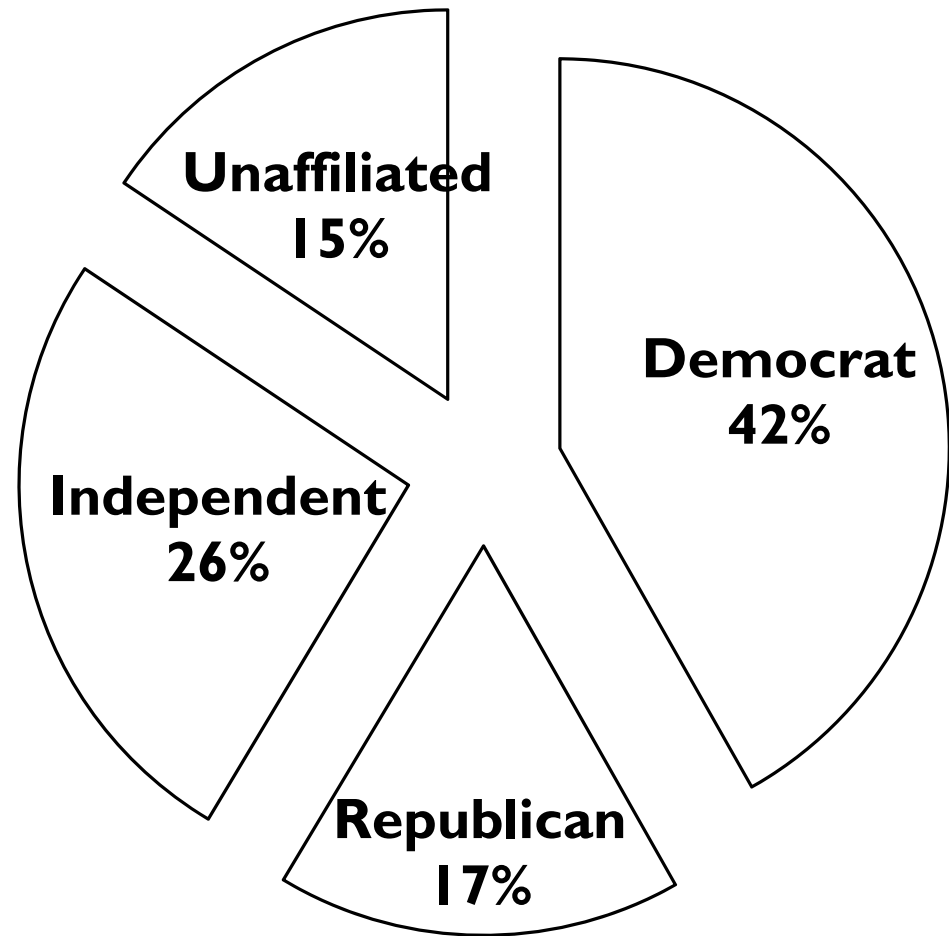
- **90%** age 18-22, oldest = **47** years old
- **58%** female; **3** people with unique gender categories
- **93%** heterosexual; **7%** unique sexual orientations
- **28%** don't work; those who work average 14.50 hrs/week
- 15% receive no family support; else 64% of income from parents
- **64%** of students self-report "upper middle class"
- 3 veterans



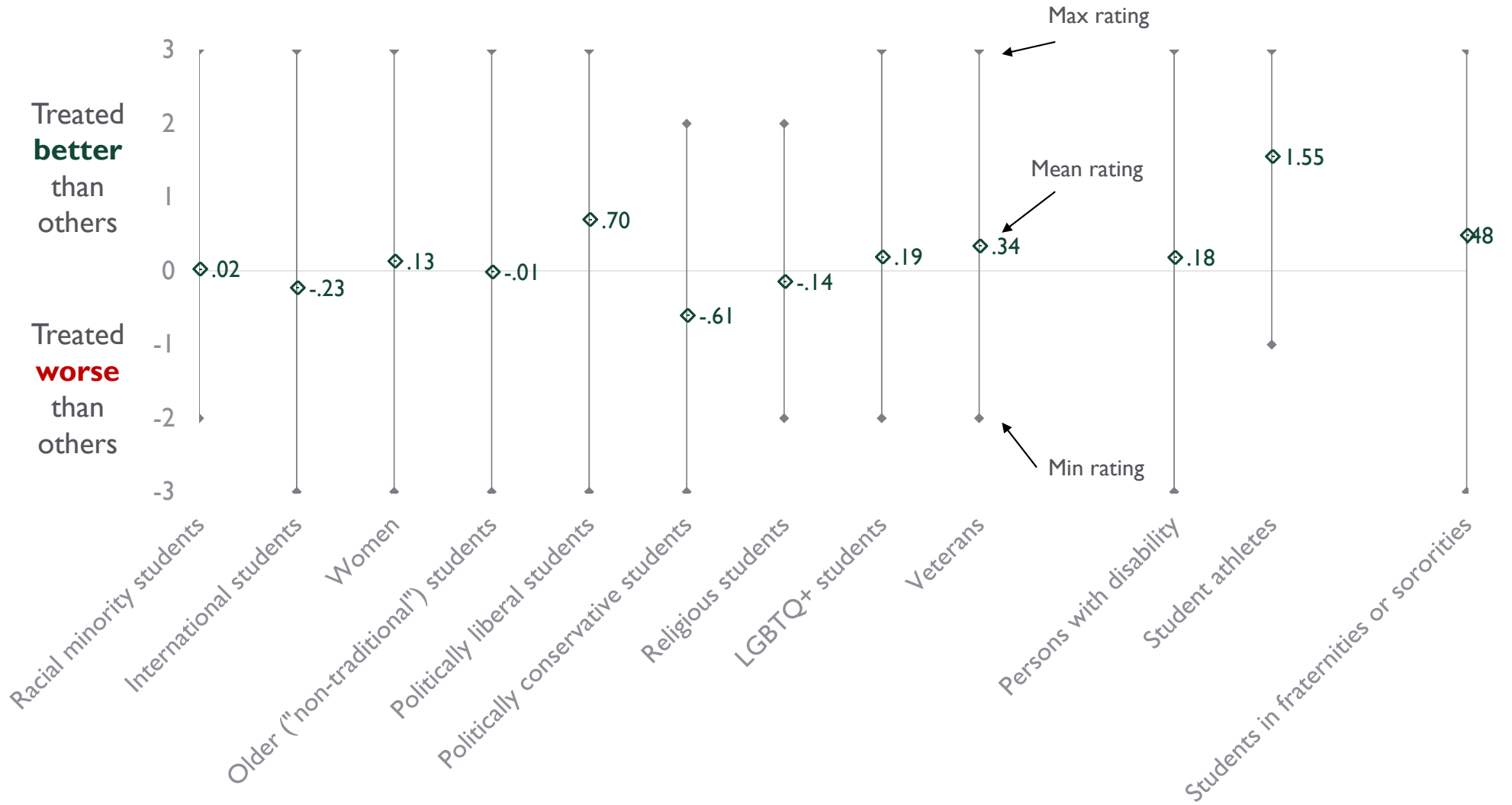




Diverse Political Views

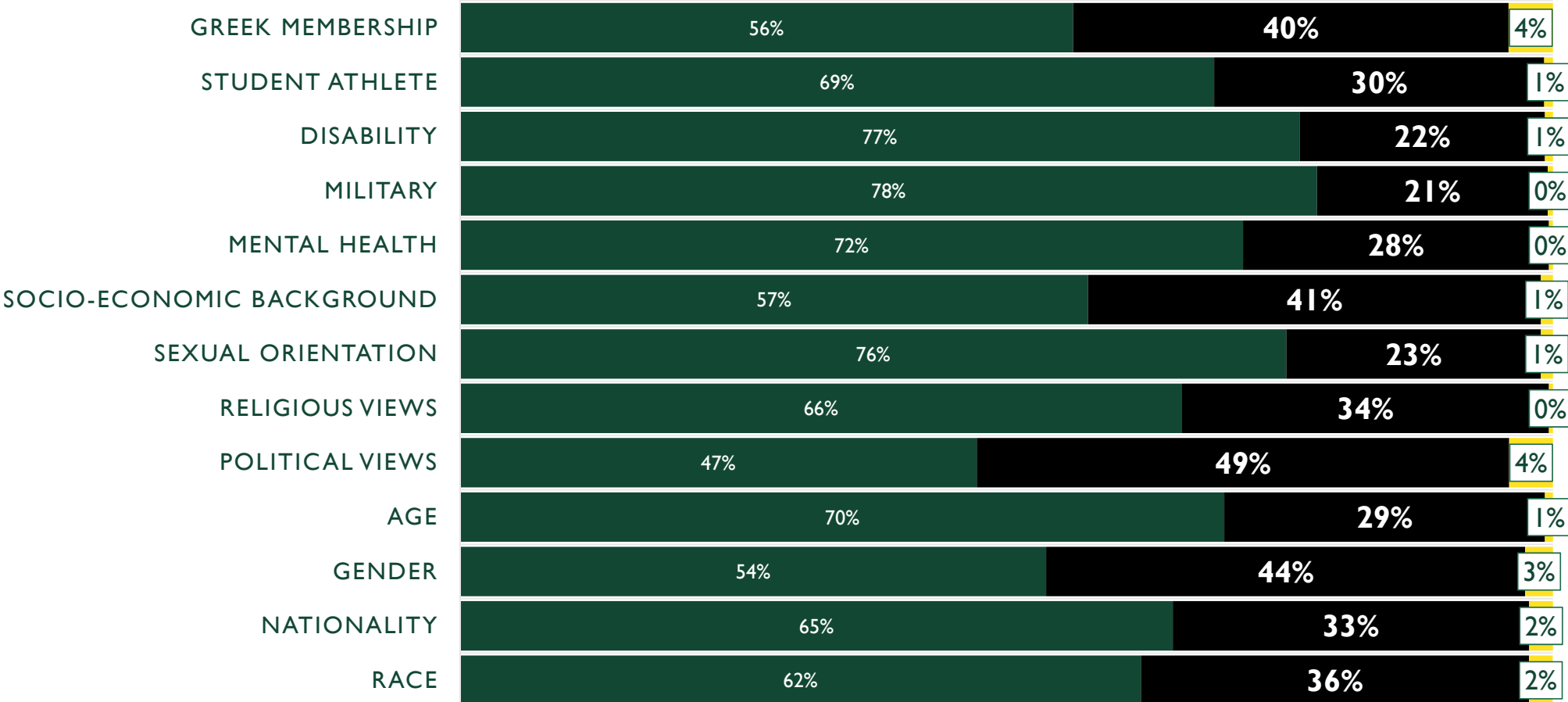


General perceptions of how groups are treated at LCB

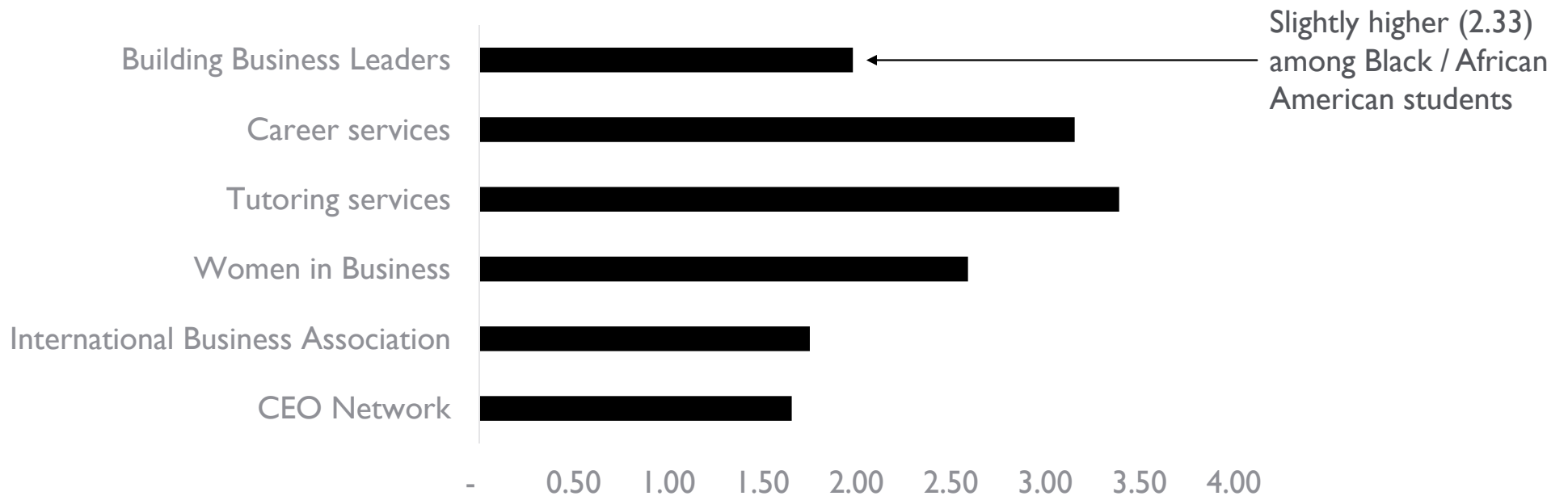

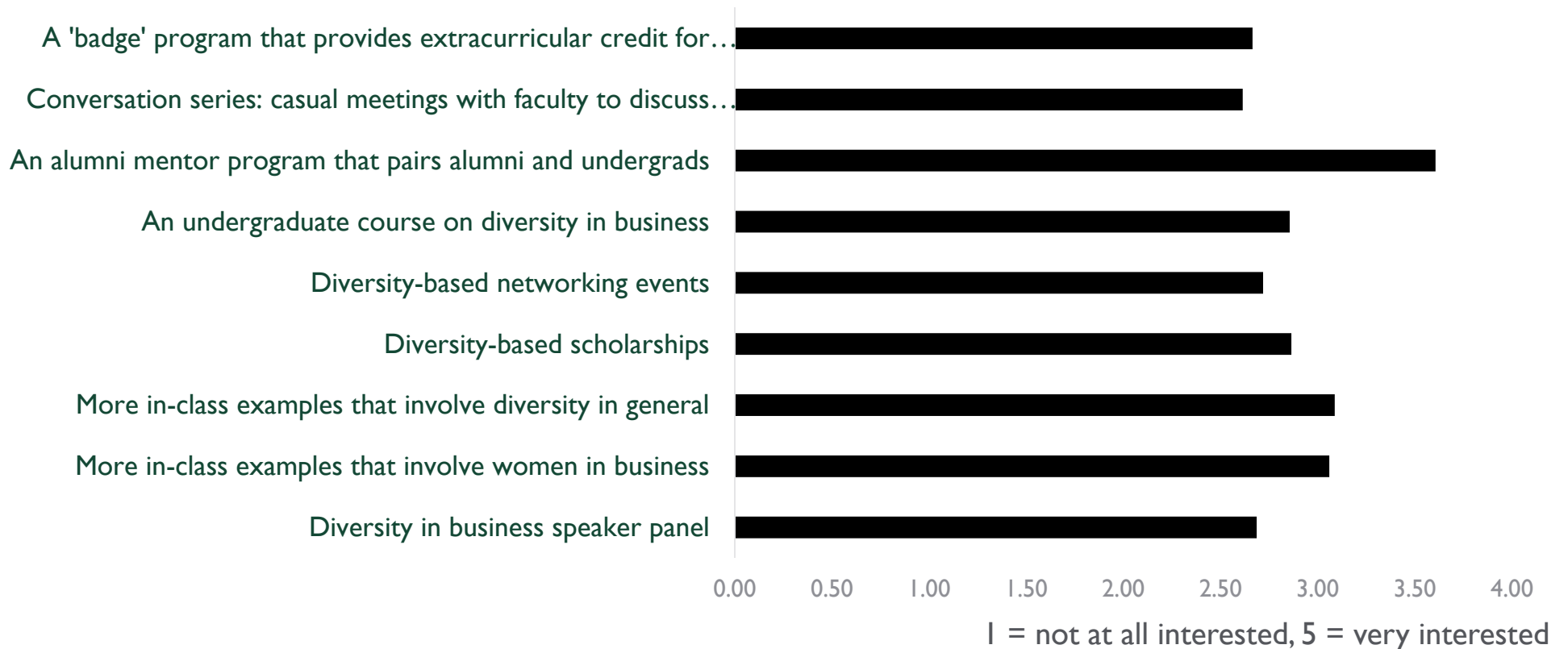

Familiarity with Current Clubs is Moderate (could be better)

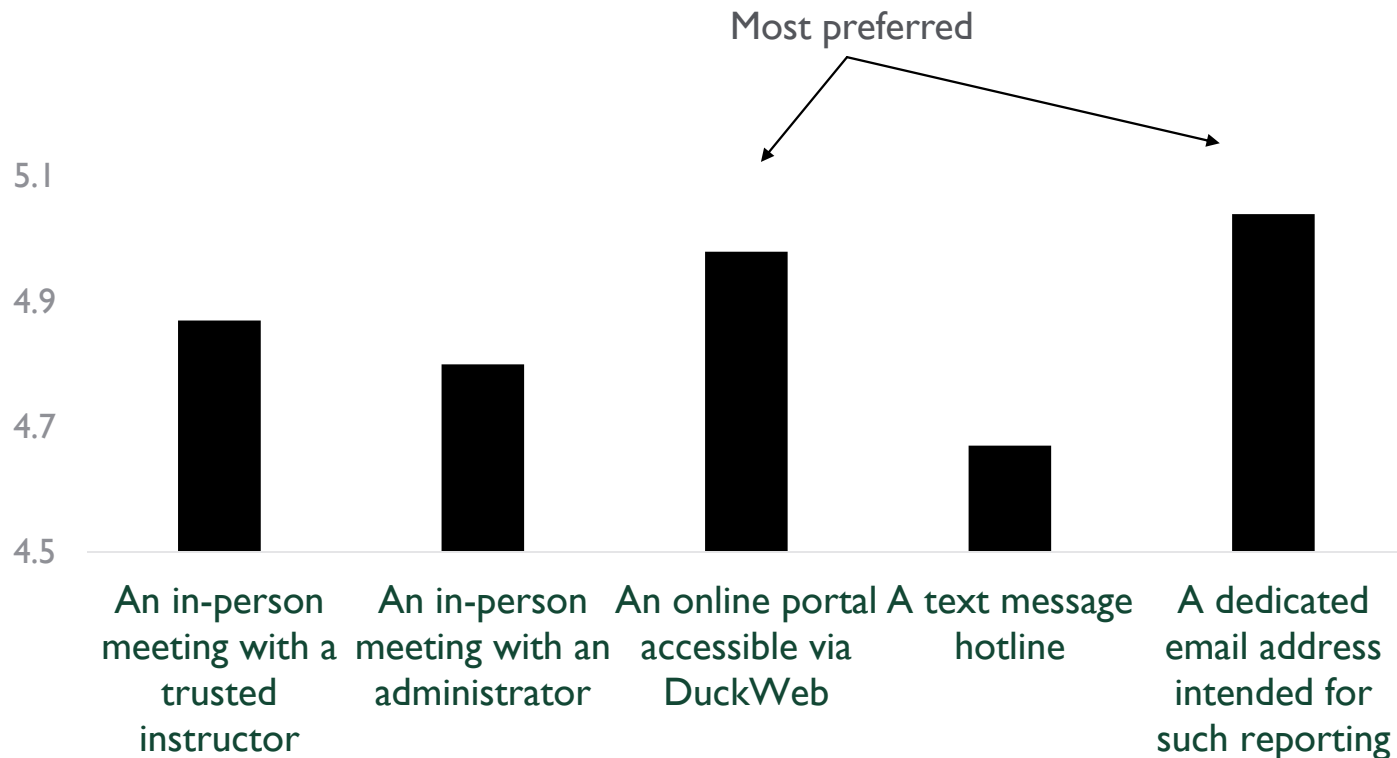


1 = not at all familiar, 5 = very familiar
