**About:** The Cameron Center for Finance and Securities Analysis at the Lundquist College of Business is proud to announce the 9<sup>th</sup> biennial summer finance conference at the University of Oregon.

**Topics:** We welcome submissions of empirical and theoretical papers in all areas of Finance. We are particularly interested in completed papers that have not yet been presented at major conferences. The programs from the previous years are available at the website of our conference.

**Paper Submission Procedure:** There is a \$50 submission fee per paper. The on-line portal for the submissions will be available from February 1<sup>st</sup> until the deadline date of April 1<sup>st</sup>. The authors of the accepted papers will be notified by May 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Travel Expenses and Arrangements:** Participants are responsible for airfare and lodging. We have secured a block of rooms at a special conference rate at Eugene's premier hotel, Inn at the 5<sup>th</sup>. There is a \$250 conference fee, which covers all beginning with a kickoff dinner on Sunday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. Monday, August 5<sup>th</sup>, will be a full day of author and discussant presentations, with a conference dinner to follow. Tuesday, August 6<sup>th</sup> will have presentations in the morning followed by a final lunch.

**Recreational Activities:** August is a particularly pleasant time of year to visit Eugene and the Pacific Northwest more generally. There are many nearby outdoor and recreational activities including hiking, biking, winetasting, visiting craft breweries, etc. We will be organizing post-conference activities for Tuesday afternoon for interested participants, including a river rafting trip on the local McKenzie River.
