


University of Oregon Guest Wireless Access

The University of Oregon campus IT community has recently launched a new guest wireless access program that allows official university guests to easily access the UO campus-wide wireless network. Guests can now create their own 7-day accounts to access the UO wireless network. Below is a series of screenshots on how to access the UO Guest network from a mobile device.

#1:

- On your mobile device select the “UO Guest” network to begin setup.



#2:

- Once the UO Guest network is selected a new window will open. Select the “Create an account” option located at the bottom of the window.

- Upon submission of the access form a guest wireless account will be created. This account will have wireless access for seven days, and can be renewed as needed. Your account information will be displayed as seen below (personal info has been removed from this example).
- You will now request your password by pressing on **one** of the two indicated buttons. Please note you will not receive a notification upon pressing the button(s) but you only need to press it once.




